**Camden City School District Black History Month Celebration
Scheduled for February 26th and 27th**

CAMDEN, NJ - On Wednesday, February 26, 2014, the Camden City School District will present a Black History Month program titled "Who is this Man" celebrating the life and work of Nelson Mandela at the Creative Arts Morgan Village Academy, 990 Morgan Boulevard, Camden, New Jersey, with performances at 10:00 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. for students.

On Thursday, February 27, 2014, beginning at 5:00 p.m., the Camden community is invited to a special performance of the district's Black History Month Celebration. The program will cover all aspects of Nelson Mandela's early life as a child, his struggles in South Africa and the struggle for freedom during apartheid and the equal rights movement, his 27 years of imprisonment, and his election as the first black president of the country he called home.
